Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter – 2025 to 2026

Dear Parents,

Here at West Winch Primary School we welcome and encourage the important link between home and school. We would like you to be fully involved with your child's education. This letter is to inform you of the topics, curriculum content and homework your child will be working through this year.

Autumn Term 2025

English – Non-chronological reports, recounts and narrative writing. There is also a major focus on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills.

Mathematics – Place value, rounding, multiplication and division, fractions, ratio, measure, position and direction.

Science – Living Things and Their Habitats and Electricity.

History- Crime And Punishment

Spring Term 2026

English – Letters From The Lighthouse – narratives, recount and explanation texts

Mathematics – Looking at all four operations using integers and decimal numbers. Recognising the equivalence between decimals, fractions and percentages. Shape and Measure. Area and perimeter of 2d shapes. Properties of 2d and 3d shapes, volume and angles.

Science – Animals, including Humans.

Geography – Economic Activity of the UK

History - Blitz and Pieces – World War II

Summer Term 2026

English – The Last Bear and McBeth (The Witches' Spell Extract) – Instructions, Non-chronological report, recounts and narratives.

Mathematics – All four operations using integers and decimal numbers; recognising the equivalence between decimals, fractions and percentages; area and perimeter of 2d shapes; translation and reflection of shapes; ratio and proportion; data handling; algebra and properties of number.

Please note that all topics are subject to change.

Homework

Homework is given as an extension to work in class and is used to reinforce and extend your child's knowledge and skills. It is a very important part of their education, so please make time for your child to complete their home activities, supporting them as needed. Just to remind you that homework in Year 6 involves reading done at home on a regular basis (**please record this in the reading record**). Also, on a Friday you will be sent Maths/English homework, which is usually due in on the following Wednesday. It is also expected that your child will spend time reviewing and revising everything they have learned in school on a regular basis. Do please support your child to ensure that homework is completed to a good standard and returned promptly.

P.E.

P.E. for Year 6 is usually on Mondays each week. Earrings can be taped down (with plasters) for P.E. lessons. If you wish your child to keep their earrings in for P.E., **please** send in plasters for them to use. Please ensure that all kit brought into school is clearly named. Year 6 will be swimming on Fridays in the Autumn Term.
